Want gorgeous hair the natural way? Our testers put nine organic shampoos through their paces

- 1. Green People Vitamin Shampoo, £8.50 (200ml)** This shampoo smells great, despite being so natural. It's got a good lather and my hair feels so soft and shiny – in absolute first class! I started bleaching it, but I haven't brought the conditioner.
- 2. Dr Hauschka Macadamia and Orange Shampoo, £14 (250ml)** Smells lovely but after a few days of using the shampoo my hair became quite dry.
- 3. map C-Stright Hydrating Shampoo, £10.95 (300ml)** Doesn't smell great, which I was surprised about as it's supposed to have fruit extract. And it left a residue.
- 4. Revlon Organic Penetration Oil and Protein Shampoo, £9.99 (200ml)** I loved this shampoo with my left hand and left hand conditioner with my right hand.
- 5. Australian Organics Hydra Stabilising Shampoo, £3.50 (250ml)** This 50p good left too has real added shine. It's definitely one I would use again.
- 6. Nails Your Nails Sweets Shampoo, £4 (200ml)** It was lovely and made my hair feel so much better. I love the smell and it's so good for my hair.
- 7. Aveda Dry Remedy Moisturizing Shampoo, £16.50 (200ml)** Smells lovely and left my hair feeling clean and manageable.
- 8. Jurlique Arnica Mint Shampoo, £15 (300ml)** The shampoo left my hair feeling incredibly smooth and shiny and it has a refreshing invigorating fragrance.
