*** RACHEL STEVENS**
Singer and face of Schwarzkopf Gliss

ROUTINE: "I'm quite good with cleansing, toning and moisturising daily. As you get older, you look after your skin more and I've started using preventative anti-wrinkle creams. If I'm not working, it's nice to have a day off from hair and make-up, which is usually when the paparazzi catch you!"

MAKE-UP MUSTS: "MAC Face & Body Foundation, Bourjois mascara, Clarins lipgloss."

BATHROOM ESSENTIAL: "Dead Sea Spa Magik Salt Brushing Scrub makes your skin really soft for summer."

ROUTINE: "I start and end each day by cleansing, toning and moisturising. I use Bobbi Brown cleanser and toner and Skin Nutrition serum, moisturiser and exfoliator. I try and give myself home facials a couple of nights a week."

BEST FEATURE: "I'm told by make-up artists my eyes are good because they can take different colours. My feet are my least favourite!"

ROUTINE: "If I'm not working, I can potentially put on more slat than when I am because I like to enjoy my face for me. I really enjoy the hair and make-up element of my job and when I'm applying it, I get to choose the styles."

MAKE-UP MUSTS: "Shu Uemura eyebrow gel, Yves Saint Laurent Touche Eclat, MAC Lipstick in Vegas Volt"

BATHROOM ESSENTIAL: "I'm mad about Jo Wood's Organics Bath Oil. It's a real weekend treat for wallowing."
