My Thoughts:

- It is a well known fact that applying moisturiser to a damp face helps the moisture to absorb and lock in. For this reason, I think spraying water on before moisturise is a good thing. I think it is also good for using to 'set' your makeup after application and makes as a nice refreshing spray for those hot days (not that us Brits have had any of those lately!)
- I particularly like Evian's Brumisateur because it is an aerosol spray. I have used the normal pump sprays many times and although the coverage with those is good, I find the aerosols are far more efficient at given you an even and light spritz.
- When using this it leaves my skin feeling fresh and plump and moisturised, I find my moisturiser soaks in better and leaves a nice finish on my face. I like that this has plenty of minerals in too, good for you skin ya know.
- I think, for what is essentially bottled water, it is expensive. To spend £3.50 on 50ml of bottled water, for me would be considered a luxury. That's not me saying I will not re-purchase, but I just couldn't use this every day and night as I would get through it too quick and just cannot afford it.
