▶ **SKINCARE** specialist Estee Lauder have unveiled Revelation Age Resisting Brightening Cream — £28 for 30ml — a new moisturiser formulated with vitamin C. Their Revelation range was developed to help skin support its natural collagen stores.

It's aimed at women who are beginning to detect a change in their skin — dullness, freckling, or the onset of fine lines — and the blurb says it's for those looking for "a bit more muscle" from their daily moisturiser.

Yet, having tried this cream for around three weeks, I have to say I've had better results from lower-priced moisturisers. It is advertised as a lightweight cream but feels a little too light for me. If you're looking for your jar to last a couple of months, this wouldn't be your first choice.
